DENTISTRY EXPERIENCE

From Oud-Turnhout, I drive around to perform ambulatory routine dental examinations and treatments in Belgium, the Netherlands and Germany.

Every week, I work stationary at Burg Müggenhausen, equine clinic in Germany. Here I perform routine and advanced dental treatments including oral surgeries on referral cases. Almost all surgeries are performed on the standing sedated horse.

During the rest of the week I work in the southern part of the Netherlands and the Belgian border region as an ambulatory dental veterinarian. Also, I perform free-lance advanced dentistry in several Dutch equine clinics. They call me to work on their referral cases and I can bring in my own patients for advanced treatments.

In 2018, I treated about 750 horses ambulatory and 250 within a clinic.

Next to dental work, I gained experience in general anesthesia and the veterinary management of a large equine hospital.

Worked as a horse dental technician during my veterinary education. Standard procedures included oral examinations and floating molar tables to progress

Work was performed without sedation or, more often, in collaboration with different veterinarians. After graduation I worked in a Dutch equine practice for 2,5 years where I took care of all their dental patients next to doing other ambulatory work.
